
ST. RITA TO ELIMINATE SCIENCE DEPARTMENT

St. Rita Undergoes Major Construction Projects; 23-24 School Year to Be Held Over Zoom

St. Rita administration announced on Tuesday, May 23, 2023, after the last day of classes, that they would be undergoing major construction and renovations over the summer and that they cannot confirm that it will be completed until the end of the next school year. This was then followed by the announcement of the next school year being held over Zoom. This, of course, made many students very happy because they would be able to play video games while in class as they did during the hybrid 20/21 school year.

Many teachers were seen on the corner of 79th and Western holding up signs that read, "NO ZOOM! KEEP US IN THE CLASSROOM!". Many of these signs confused the average citizen who was driving their car down the street assuming St. Rita administration had lost their minds and put Covid protocol back in place despite no longer being considered an emergency. The St. Rita administration offered many options to the faculty about plans for the next school year.
