

OFFICIAL DRESS CODE FOR SPIRIT DAYS

- Students who decide not to participate are to be dressed according to the regular school dress code.
- IDs must be worn
- All other dress code policies will still be enforced
- Students who wish to participate must be dressed in appropriate attire. Students should not be dressed in anything that might bring embarrassment to our school, your parents or to yourself. The student is responsible for knowing whether something is appropriate or not. If you have a question as to whether or not an article of clothing is appropriate ask the Dean of Students.

We are sure that NO STUDENT WILL FORCE THEIR TEACHERS, THE ADMINISTRATION OR THE DEAN OF STUDENTS TO ISSUE PUNISHMENTS OR GIVE DETENTIONS to students who insist on abusing and/or take advantage of the privilege given to them.
